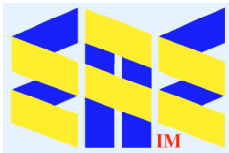

Self-Portrait (1806) Lenbachhaus



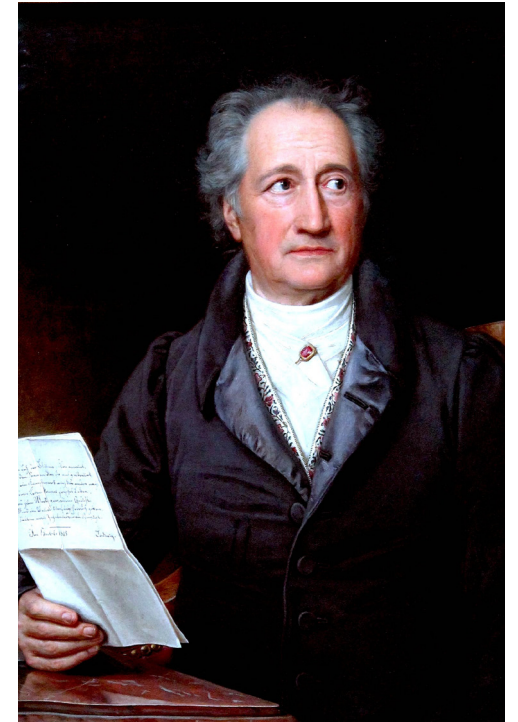

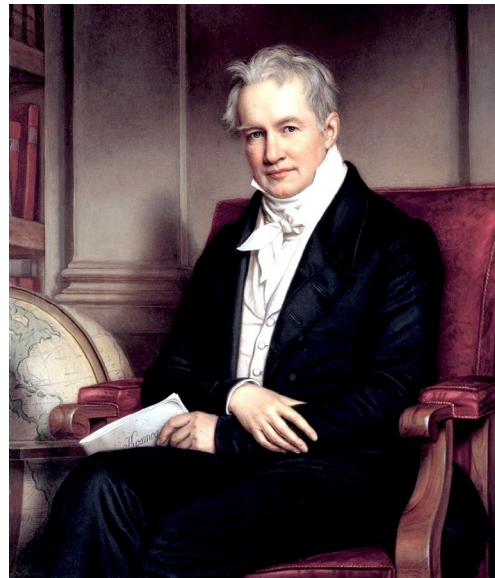

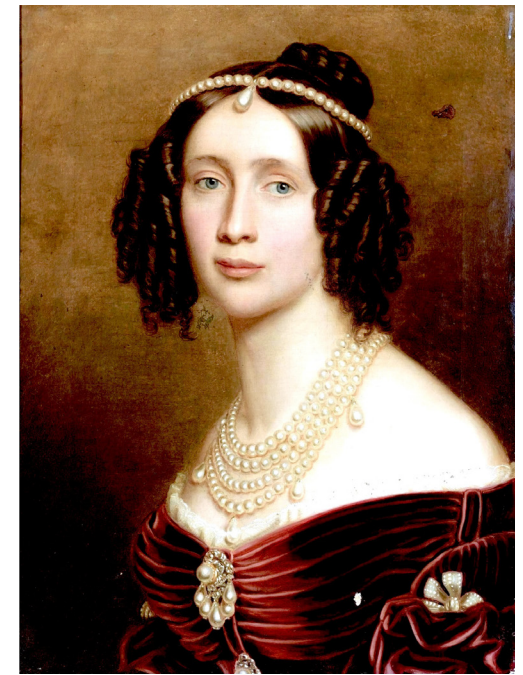

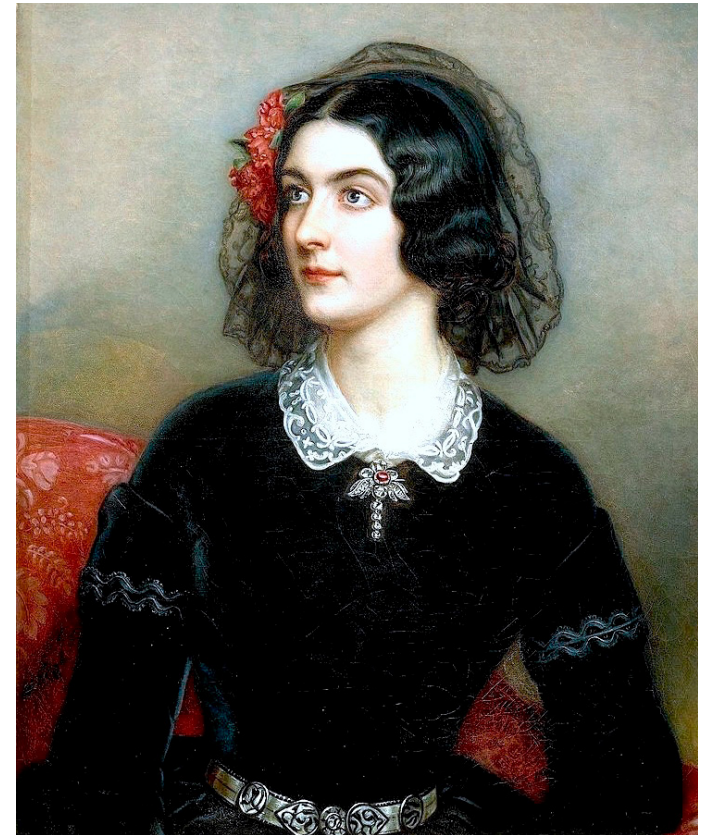

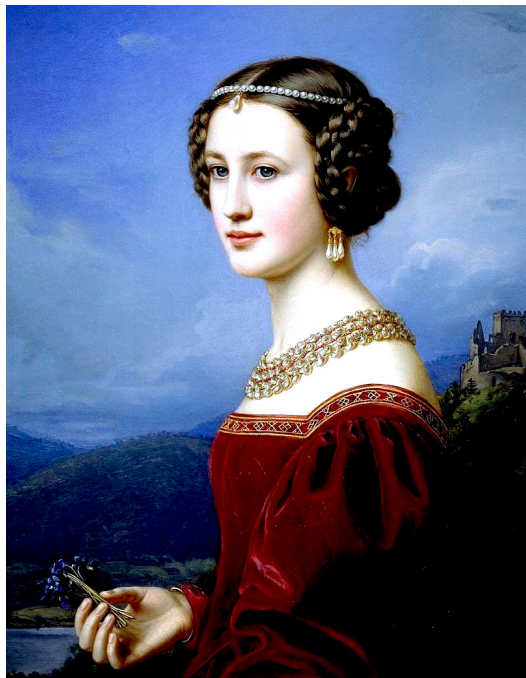

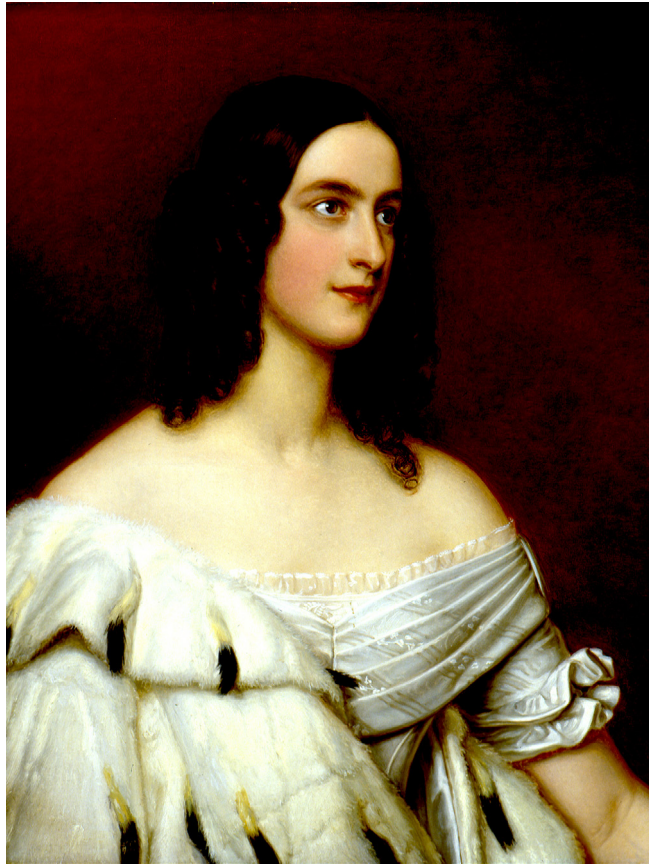

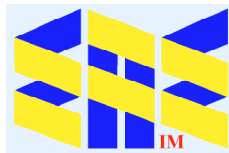


Daughter Otilie with Straw Hat (1845-48) CP
